As a member of Améi Quartett, Trio uBu, Trio Radial and Sonemus Trio, as well as partner of pianists Sophie Patey and Bernhard Ruchti, Esther Saladin's focuses on chamber music. Other engagements include work with Ensemble MusikFabrik, Ensemble Modern, Ensemble recherche, Das Neue Ensemble Hannover, Ensemble Proton, Ensemble VIL Stuttgart, Experimental studio of the SWR, and many others. Esther Saladin has received prizes and awards, including 1st prize of Kammermusikwettbewerb der Polytechnischen Gesellschaft Frankfurt' (2012/Améi Quartett) and 1st prize of Boris Pergamenschikow Chamber Music Competition in Berlin (2016/Trio uBu).
